

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
## STAAR Percent Met Standard (Approaches) All Grades, All Subjects








### STAAR Percent Met Standard (Approaches) All Grades, **Reading**








## STAAR Percent Met Standard (Approaches) All Grades, Math








## STAAR Percent Met Standard (Approaches) All Grades, Writing














