## Red Oak Independent School District Title I District Parent Involvement Policy

ROISD believes that strong home and school partnerships strengthen the education of the student. Red Oak ISD uses Title I funds to provide school wide services for students on Title I campuses and for students served under the McKinney Vento Act (homeless) on any campus.

- 1. Parents and school staff will work to revise and improve the District and Campus Parent Involvement policies. - 3. Red Oak ISD will assist campuses in guiding the schools' and parents' capacity for strong parental involvement.
  - a. Provide funds for parent involvement activities (district set-aside, campus Title I allocation)
  - b. Encourage parents to become involved in the ROISD parenting program. *(attendance sheets)*
- 4. Red Oak ISD will coordinate and integrate parental involvement strategies with other ESSA programs :
  - a. Provide funds for parent involvement activities (district set-aside, campus Title I allocation, activities conducted, sign-in sheets/attendance)
- 5. Red Oak ISD will provide assistance and support to participating schools to conduct annual Title I meetings and the annual evaluations of the Title I program at each campus. (agendas, handouts, sign in sheets, surveys)
- 6. Parents will be involved in the activities of the schools.
  - a. Campuses/district will provide opportunities for parental involvement through activities, conferences, progress reporting, translators, translations, etc.)
