<u>Additional Agreement Details</u>

- Upon closing, the City shall transfer and be responsible for all utilities associated with the District Property.
- However, the District will remain responsible for any utilities used by the District during the District's continued use of the District Property after closing.
- The District and the District's Education Foundation will be able to use the multiuse facilities located on the District Property at no cost. Any group associated directly with the District will be able to rent the facilities at 50% off the normal rate.
- The City agrees to allow the District access to and the use of the 200 wing at the District Property for general storage. The District agrees to maintain the storage area in compliance with the City's adopted fire and building codes. The District will lease the designated storage within the 200 wing at the District Property for \$1.00 per year for up to 5 years.

Additional Agreement Details cont.

- The City will allow District staff access to and utilization of the fitness facility at the District Property at no cost for as long as it is operated by the City.
- The City agrees to accommodate program space at a cost of \$1.00 per year for the Education Foundation. The program space shall be within the public access area of the 200 wing at the District Property.
- From the date of closing on the District Property the city will allow the District to occupy their existing program space at 101 Live Oak (ACORN). The City will provide the District notice of no less than 60 days of the need to vacate the facility.
