Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 by Shondra Jones, Director of School and Family Services, with 20 members present on the Zoom link. After the welcome, the meeting began with a review of the approval of the District of Innovation Renewal Plan by Shondra Jones. The school board approved the DOI renewal plan unanimously on April 19, 2021. The plan is posted on the district website.

Shondra Jones also reviewed the updated District Improvement Plan (DIP), and opened the floor for questions/comments. Melissa Sulak, the new Director of Assessment and Accountability, was introduced and will be instrumental in assisting the district and campuses in the revision of the DIP/CIPs next school year.

Rachael Little, Coordinator for Secondary ELAR, reviewed a proposal for the state required 7th grade reading diagnostic instrument. Mrs. Little reviewed four reading instruments, and proposed a recommendation to the committee on Mindplay as the approved diagnostic reading instrument for 7th grade students. A poll was launched after the review for DAC members to vote on the recommendation as presented. The vote was 100% in favor of acquiring Mindplay for our 7th grade diagnostic reading instrument.

Lynn Dockery, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, presented the professional development plan for August 2021, for elementary and secondary staff. No questions or concerns were noted.

Superintendent Sanford presented remarks regarding the State of the District meetings held this week, along with another option to attend during the Chamber Meeting. She also discussed the two upcoming board meetings and some of the topics that would be discussed.

Donny Lutrick, DAC member, expressed his thanks to the teachers for everything they've done during this pandemic, and throughout his son's academic career in Red Oak ISD. Mr. Lutrick's son will be graduating from Red Oak High School this June.

The floor was opened for questions/comments.
