Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 by Shondra Jones, with 21 members present on the Zoom link. After the welcome, the meeting began with a review of the District of Innovation Renewal Plan by Scott Rogers, Executive Director of Curriculum and Instruction. A poll was launched after the review for DAC members to vote on the District of Innovation Renewal Plan as presented. The vote was 100% in favor of presenting the plan as presented to the School Board in April. Mr. Rogers will proceed with the next steps of submitting to TEA and the 30-day public posting.

Shondra Jones, Director of School and Family Services, reviewed the District Improvement Plan (DIP), and opened the floor for questions/comments. Scott Rogers advised the members of the new Director of Accountability and Assessment, Melissa Sulak, who will start after Spring Break. Ms. Sulak will be instrumental in assisting the district and campuses in the revision of the DIP/CIPs next school year.

Scott Rogers reviewed the CPR Instruction Waiver for the committee. He explained that due to COVID-19, TEA offered waivers to districts for consideration through the district-level planning committee, which is the DAC for Red Oak ISD. The committee voted 100% to move forward with the CPR Instruction Waiver.

The floor was opened for questions/comments.

The next meeting is scheduled for May 6, 2021 at 4:30 pm, via Zoom, and will be our final meeting of the 2020-2021 school year, unless we need to meet earlier.
