

Dear Parents and Guardians,

***The instructors of the Navy JROTC want to welcome your students to Red Oak High School!***

You may not have considered NJROTC but we are probably not what you think we are. We believe we have something unique to offer; an elective with a diverse syllabus that includes academics, teamwork, leadership, and one that counts as a PE CREDIT (we have PE only once a week versus 5 times a week in a regular PE class). Students do not incur any military obligation if they sign up for this class but if they are considering the military in their future being a part of JROTC can result in advanced rank and pay when they join ANY branch of the service after high school.
