If you wish to complete an activity not explicitly listed below, it <u>must be pre-approved</u> and signed by one of the advisors! These guidelines are effective as of June, 2012 until further notice.

FOR THREE (3) OR MORE HOURS:

- 1. Any activity announced by NHS (at a meeting or on announcements)
- 2. Babysitting during a PTA meeting or any other parent meeting at an ROISD school
- 3. Tutoring a student not related to you ONLY when school-sponsored
- 4. Volunteering for a non-profit organization (the Outreach Center, SPCA, etc.)
- 5. Warm Up America
- 6. Helping at band competitions in which you are not participating
- 7. Coaching or helping a little league team for any sport
- 8. Helping with Girl Scouts or Boy Scouts
- 9. Working at a soup kitchen or at a food bank
- 10. After School Candy Sales
- 11. Assisting the ROISD Education Foundation
- 12. Habitat for Humanity

FOR ONE (1) HOUR ONLY:

- 1. Donating approved items for the NHS drive of the six weeks
- 2. Working as an aid to a teacher (not a relative)
- 3. Participating in an activity (not part of a worship service) at or through your church

NOT APPROVED:

- 1. Working/volunteering for a business
- 2. Your Eagle Scout project
- 3. Babysitting for a friend, neighbor, etc.
- 4. Working at an activity in which you benefit (i.e. Senior class activities; selling/working for an activity or organization that you directly benefit from). Setting up for a Band Banquet if you are a band student does not count. Working the concession stand for baseball, if you play baseball, does not count.
