The Red Oak High School Soccer Booster Club believes that student athletes' accomplishments deserve recognition.

A total of four (4) \$500.00 scholarships will be awarded, to any eligible soccer player, who will be pursuing post high school education.

The purpose of this scholarship is to reward student/athletes for their participation and accomplishments in athletics, their academic performance, their character, their leadership, and their service to the community.

Any interested senior soccer player meeting the eligibility requirements listed on the following page may apply by completing the attached application form and turning it onto the school counselor's office no later than **Friday, April 10th, by 4:05 P.M.**

Any applications NOT turned in as instructed above will be automatically denied.

Eligibility Checklist

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship:

- Applicant must be a Red Oak High School graduating senior.
- Applicant must have a minimum weighted GPA of 2.5.
- Applicant must have completed at least three (3) years in a High School soccer program.
- Applicant parent/legal guardian must be a paid ROHS Soccer Booster member for the qualifying year.
- Applicant must have donated time and/or talent in service to the community- volunteer work at school, church, nursing home, charitable organization, etc.
- **Applicant must complete the application, submit a copy of his/her transcript, provide a letter of recommendation and write one essay. All information must be legible, correct and verifiable.**
- Applicant must have a good disciplinary record with the school.
- Applicant or applicant representative must volunteer a minimum of six (6) hours for the qualifying year toward the booster club.
- Applicant must plan to attend a two-year or four-year college, university, trade school or the military.

The awarding of the scholarship will be based on an objective assessment of all of the information provided by the applicant. Points will be awarded for each category of the Participation Portion of the Application. The essay will be graded on 1-25-point scale.

Presentation of the winners will take place as part of the Red Oak High School Soccer Banquet as well as the scholarship night at the high school.

Funds will be released prior to September 30, of the graduating year. The applicant must show proof of enrollment to a two-year or four-year college, university, trade school or the military no later than **August 1, of the graduating year** to qualify for the scholarship. Failure to show proof of enrollment by August 1st will result in the forfeiture of the scholarship.
