

# Red Oak I.S.D. Emergency Action Plan

Red Oak High School Gymnasiums

## **Emergency Personnel:**

Licensed/Certified Athletic Trainer, Coach, or Student Athletic Trainer on site for practice/competition

## **Emergency Communication:**

Athletic Trainers/Coaches will be equipped with cellular telephones. If not available, a fixed phone line will be available at Red Oak High School

## **Emergency Equipment:**

Emergency supplies are located in the athletic training facilities including: AED, splints, spine board, with the Athletic Trainer on site

## **In Case of an Emergency:**

### **Emergency Roles: First Responders**

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
2. Emergency Equipment Retrieval if necessary
3. Call 911 (Activation of emergency medical system) EMS
  - Provide name, address, telephone number of caller
  - Number of individuals injured; condition of injured
  - First-aid treatment initiated by First Responder
  - Specific directions as needed to locate scene (what entrance)
  - Other information as requested by dispatcher
4. Direction of EMS to scene
  - Open appropriate doors
  - Designate individual to “flag down” EMS and direct to scene
  - Have EMS park in the fire lane between the basketball gym and parking lot for emergencies
  - Scene control: Limit scene to first-aid responders and move bystanders away from area
